Radio Systems – D. Taylor provided an update of current TCERN system progress. Cutover is still on track to take place in November with Law at 7 am November 18th and Fire/EMS at 8 am November 19th. Motorola has successfully completed the three tests needed to have the system certified by TCOMM. Those tests included the coverage acceptance test plan, the network acceptance test plan and the radio system operation test plan. The Radio Systems HelpDesk is up and running and policies and procedures are being drafted. The quick reference guides were made available after today's meeting and an email will be sent shortly with the native file for any future updates each agency might need to make. There are a few non-member agency agreements that are still in the process of being completed.

FLAC Subcommittee Report – J. Elkins stated the Committee agreed to cancel their December meeting in lieu of the Joint Operations/FLAC meeting later in the month.

Old Business

Field Ops Update – W. Hill stated the Field Ops agreement has been approved by both the Tumwater and Central Square legal departments. The Central Square representative will reach out to those agencies that volunteered for the two week test period soon. Once completed and feedback is received, agencies will be able to sign the agreement and elect a primary user who will be responsible for adding/removing users for their agencies.

New Business

HIRL Fall Drill – J. Elkins stated their were conflicts with the fall HIRL drill date and advised a new date has been proposed but is still waiting on a few responses from other agencies to confirm a date for the first week of December. Once finalized, an email will be sent with the date, time, and the Zoom information.

Simulcast Changes – J. Elkins proposed updating the policy and procedure to remove the simulcast on the tone out channel and the responding channel every time there is a size up, staging, or cancellation on the fireside, to just the responding channel. A short discussion took place it was agreed to update the policy and procedure.
